 **NFPA 1901: Annex D, Part 1 of 2**

 During 2003, the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) updated its standards for fire apparatus (NFPA 1901, 2003 edition). The updated standards modernized many of the requirements for modern fire apparatus; they also include safety standards that should be included for apparatus already in service that were not manufactured to the new standards. Recommendations were made outside the 1901 standard itself and were included in an addendum to the document found in "Annex D." This two-part program will discuss recommendations of the NFPA committee that were included in Annex D. Our presentation will show you what safety, performance and reliability elements to consider. These two programs will help you decide

where your maintenance, replacement and new vehicle dollars should be spent, and help you with your fire apparatus program's cost/benefit analysis.

 **Emergency Incident Rehabilitation, Part 1 of 2**

 Incident commanders, company officers and safety personnel should recognize the environmental conditions and establish rehab operations early. The need for emergency incident rehabilitation is cited in several national standards. Recent studies have concluded that a properly implemented fireground rehabilitation program will result in fewer accidents and injuries to firefighters. Moreover, responders who are given prompt and adequate time to rest and rehydrate may safely re-enter the operational scene, which may reduce the requirement for additional staffing at an incident.
