| A+ | American Heat | Fires In Sprinklered Buildings | 054-0058 | 60 minute video plus course materials | Myth: Buildings with sprinkler systems do not need fire department support. Reality: Firefighters have lost their lives to fires in sprinklered buildings because of design deficiencies, before and during the fire, as well as human factors. Learn the basics of how sprinkler systems function and some of the issues firefighters face upon their first arrival to sprinklered buildings. |
| A+ | PULSE | Care Across Cultures | 464-0206 | 30 minute video plus course materials | The face of our nation has changed dramatically. And in the next 50 years, all major minority groups are estimated to increase in population. To meet the demands of such a diverse culture, healthcare facilities need employees who can work well with patients and co-workers from different backgrounds. This course increases staff sensitivity to cultural differences and offers guidelines for working within a diverse environment. |
| A+ | Firefighter Training | Fire Behavior, Part 3 | 047-0197 | 30 minute video plus course materials | The third installment of our series on fire behavior will extend your knowledge and improve your effectiveness on the fireground. Building on the application of basic fire behavior principles, this course sparks discussion on the dangers of fire. Chris DeWolf presents more scenarios using the prop built to NFPA 1403 standards. Live examples of fire, materials burning, smoke development, and some extinguishing methods are demonstrated. |
| A+ | Firefighter Training | Fire Behavior, Part 4 | 047-0198 | 30 minute video plus course materials | Using a burn prop that was built to NFPA 1403 standards, Chris DeWolf continues to demonstrate how a fire reacts. Principles about the final stage of fire (decay stage) and the potential dangers of backdraft are discussed. Also, Capt. David McLean shares some experiences about the dangers of backdraft and flashover conditions. |
| A+ | Firefighter Training | Radiological Monitoring, Part 1 | 720-0070 | 30 minute video plus course materials | This often-misunderstood source of invisible harm to citizens and responders alike is not dealt with often, but when we cross its path, we must know what we are being exposed to. Besides making it safer for you and your community, this course provides training that will help your community maximize its ISO rating. |
| A+ | American Heat | Medical Response to Terrorism | 463-1002 | 30 minute video plus course materials | This course covers medical response to terrorism and some suggestions on how you can help your fire crews prepare for such an event. The terrorist threat as it relates to the fire service is described. The course looks at basic triage tactics firefighters may need to perform during a terrorism incident response. Finally, the course describes community resources such as MRC/CERT and how to utilize them. |
| A+ | PULSE | Airway Management | 464-0308 | 30 minute video plus course materials | This program deals with airway management issues common to EMS providers. It includes anatomy and physiology of the lungs to include the exchange of gases at the alveolar level and basic techniques of ventilation (BVM and associated airway adjuncts and assessment of effectiveness of ventilatory efforts. | A+ | American Heat | Manufactured Housing | 054-0078 | 60 minute video plus course materials | A manufactured home can deal responders a mixed bag of fire hazards. Although new factory homes are federally regulated for safety, older models are still around, they are still catching on fire, and they still burn fast. In this edition of American Heat, you hear from two departments who know the devastation these structure fires can produce--inside and out. In Oklahoma, a department lost 22 manufactured homes in one day as a result of a wildland fire. A year later, as Pennsylvania department lost one of its own inside a manufactured home structure fire. Both incidents show how manufactured housing fires can threaten a department's firefighting efforts and life safety. |
| A+ | Firefighter Training | Radiological Monitoring, Part 2 | 737-0114 | 30 minute video plus course materials | This course covers discusses the four kinds of ionizing radiation and the dangers to emergency responders presented by each. The proper shielding and precautions are taught as well as compounds that are the usual sources of radiation. Fission and fissile materials are explained. The four basic protection principles are emphasized. |

| A+ | Firefighter Training | How to Conquer Subordinate Counseling | 038-0308 | 60 minute video plus course materials | If you are in a supervisory position with subordinate employees, subordinate counseling and discipline are inevitable. Too many supervisors take one of two extremes; They try to be a "buddy" to all of the employees, and the entire organization suffers. Or they try to be the hard-nosed boss who disciplines employees without creating an atmosphere of mutual trust, respect, and understanding. Properly administering discipline is a responsibility and challenge that all supervisors must face. Ignoring this responsibility will bring liability on the organization and on yourself. Supervisors are being sued for not properly overseeing and disciplining employees. Organizations are being held responsible for their managers' lack of discipline as well. This course will show you how to fairly and consistently enforce policy as a supervisor. |
| A+ | American Heat | Prison/Jail Fires | 463-1202 | 60 minute video plus course materials | Your Halligan tool may get you through drywall, but it is no match for iron bars. Do you have the tools and the knowledge you need to fight a fire in your local lockup? This edition of American Heat profiles two incidents where lives were lost during prison or jail fires. You hear the stories of inmates who died because they couldn't get out, and firefighters who died because they got locked in. Both stories illustrate why it is so important to know every access and egress point and who controls it--prior to a fire. This course also introduces you to some of the most common hazards and fire safety mechanisms found in a typical jail. |
