While there is no one device or solution that will effectively prevent all types of accidental childhood injuries, emergency medical technicians will realize the benefits of Safe Kids coalitions, which combine several factors to create programs that reduce injuries by educating adults and children, creating safe environments, conducting research, and advocating for effective laws. |
| A+ | PULSE | PULSE: Transport of the Bariatric Patient | 464-0807 | 30 minute video plus course materials | With the growing epidemic of obesity in the public, EMS providers and rescue personnel are being challenged to understand how to care for grossly overweight patients as well as how to transport them safely, without endangering themselves and the patients in the process. |

This course reviews the basic theory involving forcible entry tools as well as window, door, and lock construction. Part one of this forcible entry series is a solid review of the targets and equipment required to safely and effectively carry out forcible entry operations on the fireground. |

| A+ | Firefighter Training | The Hazards of Fighting Trash Container Fires, Part 1: Overview | 038-0031 | 30 minute video plus course materials | This course discusses the hazards of fires that involve trash and garbage. These fires can expose firefighters to toxic materials, and suppression efforts may be adversely affected by smoke or chemicals that were not disposed of properly in the dumpsters. Firefighters with a solid understanding of the dangers of these fires can use tactics to stabilize the incident and reduce property damage. With this knowledge, firefighters will be better able to protect the public and themselves. |
| A+ | Firefighter Training | The Hazards of Fighting Trash Container Fires, Part 2: Initial Operations at Trash Container Fires | 038-0032 | 30 minute video plus course materials | Firefighters can never afford to treat any call as routine. This is true no matter how small the incident and no matter what part of the country they work in. For example, in Phoenix, an oversized trash container fire grew out of control, eventually overtaking a grocery store and leading to the loss of Brett Tarver. It is hard to imagine that such a relatively small beginning could lead to such a tragedy. In this course, visit Atlanta in order to present all the considerations when dealing with oversized trash container fires. |

This course identifies the common construction traits of strip malls and identifies challenges caused by the huge variety of strip mall occupants. It also reviews the automatic detection and suppression systems and the proper management of heat and smoke. |

Response to hurricanes Katrina and Rita taught the emergency services that even remote communities away from the direct path of a natural disaster could be significantly impacted by the event. Communities not normally impacted by hurricanes found themselves struggling to meet added demand from thousands of evacuees. This course proposes updates to the roles of emergency responders. It will assist leaders in estimating what types of disaster preparation and training are needed for communities. The course also helps emergency responders consider what disaster recovery resources might be needed and facilitates the development of contingency plans in case some expected resources are not available. |
